## **Protocol of C-19 Prevention Measures and Recommendations**

**ISMF Ski Mountaineering World Cup Finals**

**25th - 28th March 2021**

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## **INTRODUCTION TO THE COVID-19 PREVENTION PROTOCOL**

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the ISMF WORLD CUP FINALS Madonna di Campiglio (TN – Italia) scheduled from 25th to 28th March 2021 must be held under increased security measures.

Due to the current national and local regulations, according to ISMF prevention measures and Organizing Committee dispositions (LOC) we hereby send the protocol of instructions to be taken by the participants at Madonna di Campiglio event.

This action is part of a wider project of Prevention and Safety against COVID 19 Risk, adopted by the LOC, in partnership with local authorities to protect workers health and the entire community as well.

We kindly ask you to forward this protocol to all team members (athletes, coaches, service people, officials etc.) who will attend the event.

By registering for this event, each team member entirely confirms and accepts the contents of this protocol of measurements for the above mentioned event in full and undertakes to respect it for the good and the health of the community.

This protocol is composed by general and specific measures of prevention mentioned below, covering behavioural and organizing requirements, both collective and individual.

According to the following suggestions, it is recommended to each participant to independently ensure that specific containment measures for COVID 19 risk are developed.

## **GENERAL PREVENTIVE MEASURES**

### **1. Distance and Protection**

It is mandatory to maintain in every situation and condition interpersonal safety distance of at least 2 meters (social distancing) and to wear Individual respiratory Protection Equipment (respiratory IPE) in all indoor areas, except for private living quarters, and in all outdoor places, apart from all the specific situations for which is possible to guarantee a continuous condition of isolation.

For those who are carrying out sports activities this obligation may be waived (see below).

Anyway it is strongly recommended to use the Individual respiratory Protection Equipment (respiratory IPE FFP2 mask) also inside the private living quarters (e.g. Hotel rooms) in case of presence of not permanently cohabitant people.

Therefore, unless otherwise specified:

It is mandatory to always wear a protection to mouth and nose (face mask) on the entire location of the event, except:

- inside the private living quarters (e.g. Hotel rooms);
- during mealtimes;
- during the practice of sport: pre-race activity on/off the track
- exclusively the athletes involved on the warm up zone and the starting area (according to social distancing precaution)

### **2. Sanification**

The use of the Individual respiratory Protection Equipment (FFP2 mask) is reinforced with the other measures of control of the infection as the constant and careful hand hygiene and the disinfection of equipment and materials.

### **3. Rules of Conduct**

From 10 pm to 5 am the only movements allowed are for demonstrated needs (e.g. Health reasons).

It is strongly recommended, for the rest of the day, to move from your accommodation strictly for purposes relating the event activities, taking care, wherever possible, to avoid gatherings.

So, please, spend your free time only with your team members, in small groups.  
Minimise your activities to the necessary purchases and the urgent tasks that you can't absolutely postpone.

### 4. Avoid gatherings

It is mandatory for all the public places, cabins ski lift and adjacent access spaces included, to expose at the entrance signboards with the requirements about the maximum number of people simultaneously allowed.

Each one of us has to observe this maximum number of people allowed in.

We recommend a good and previous organization to avoid a delay on the fixed time because of a long wait.

To reduce at the minimum the risk of infection, the LOC advise to all the teams the following:

- Remain in small groups;
- Avoid other teams contact;
- Avoid LOC staff contact;
- Avoid tourist and fans contact;
- Journalists interview only at distance and with Individual respiratory Protection Equipment (FPP2 mask);
- Wash and sanitize properly and periodically your hands;
- Have a documentation of your current state of health

## **SPECIFIC PREVENTIVE MEASURES**

### **1. Racing in Italy and Travel Restriction**

Nowadays, in Italy, are allowed only events and competitions organized by National and International Sports Federations and without an audience (called “closed events”).

The athlete training sessions are granted without audience presence too, according to Federation protocols and observing the requirement about social distancing of at least 2 meters.

In case of athletes, coaches, judges and race stewards or companions arriving from Countries for which entry in Italy is forbidden or for which the quarantine is requested, before entering Italy, they have to perform an antigenic or molecular COVID 19 test to verify their health status not older than 48 hours upon arrival on Italian territory (last update DPCM 2nd March 2021)


### **Journey to Madonna di Campiglio**

- In case of COVID-19 symptoms do not travel to the venue.
- Avoid stops between the departure point and the event location.
- Avoid contact with other people - especially outside the team.

## PREVENTION PLAN CONCEPT

Following the ISMF Prevention Guidelines the core element to guarantee a good level of safety shall be creating different groups of people, “bubbles”, whereby groups regularly tested and disciplined to follow rules and regulations shall be limited to interact with persons not being subject to strict protocols.

## HEALTH AND TEST PROTOCOL

All the members of RED (ISMF-teams) and YELLOW (Media) bubble, are obliged to present a negative **PCR test** (not rapid antigenic!) not older than **48 hours** before arriving in Madonna di Campiglio (max. 48h between taking the sample/smear and collecting the accreditation).

Test results (pdf document translate in english) must be send at least 12 hours before arrival by email to the LOC C19 Support Office: [c19support@3trecompiglio.it](mailto:c19support@3trecompiglio.it)

A **C19 Test and Health Center** will be operating in Madonna di Campiglio at all times during the event to monitor eventual symptomatic cases and perform rapid antigenic tests if this should be the case.

A positive result will determine exclusion from the race and withdrawal of accreditation.

People who test positive will not be allowed to take part to the event and the specific procedure for C-19 positive case will follow.

In order to return to their homecountry after the event, for those who need to perform a certified anti-gen test, the testing service will be available at the LOC **C19 Test and Health Center**.

**No PCR tests are available.**

The appointments for the these tests will be fixed on Saturday 27th or Sunday 28th March 2021.

Please book early by sending the request via email to [c19support@3trecompiglio.it](mailto:c19support@3trecompiglio.it) or by indicating the request in the event registration form by **19th March 2021**.

The cost of the test booked by the deadline is **50€**, fore last minute requests the price will be **70€**.

### COVID-19 Communication

- In case of symptoms immediately inform the LOC at the **3Tre C19 Test and Health Center**
- LOC activates the COVID-19 rescue chain
- All communication regarding COVID-19 must be coordinated with ISMF and the LOC



Due the current situation, the LOC must limit the number of accredited persons, we remind all the stakeholders to reduce the accreditation request to the necessary number of people who are really involved during the World Cup Races.

### ACCREDITATION PROCEDURE

- Each participant must fill up and send the accreditation request form by **Friday 19th March 2021** (Google form)
- Within 12 hours of arrival in Madonna di Campiglio, the certificate of the negative PCR test carried out prior to arrival at the site must be sent to: [c19support@3trecampiglio.it](mailto:c19support@3trecampiglio.it)
- Upon arrival, participants must go directly to the Event Headquarters presenting the “Questionnaire for accredited persons” (appendix 1).

The accreditation procedure will be checked and only at the end of the registration process the applicant can pick up the accreditation, the accommodation voucher and occupy the booked room in the hotel.

Only the team captain or a team representative can collect all team's accreditations.

Please note that specific protection measurements have been adopted on the event site to protect the employees of the LOC and all the others; requirements that must also be observed by the teams when they approach the staff; these provisions are contained in the COVID 19 risk prevention / protection system adopted by the LOC.

Due to the Covid emergency, in order to guarantee the effectiveness of the prevention system put in place by the LOC, the accommodation of all the people accredited to the event will be managed by the organization. Furthermore, currently almost all the accommodation facilities in Madonna di Campiglio are closed due to the restrictions imposed by the health emergency, in order to be able to better manage the service, the accommodation office of the LOC will deal directly with the hotel bookings of the teams. Regarding the meals, it will be necessary to follow a precise Covid protocol, which will require that meals will be always taken at the hotel respecting specific times that will be assigned to everyone to avoid participants from mixing.

All the teams and other participant must send the reservation request to [accommodation3tre@campigliodolomiti.it](mailto:accommodation3tre@campigliodolomiti.it) by the following deadline:

- **Friday 12th march 2021:** Team size
- **Friday 19th march 2021:** detailed rooming list

- The LOC will reserve exclusive team accommodation (no audience/tourists).
- Should team members arrive early or leave later the booking request, please inform the LOC immediately at the following e-mail address: [accommodation3tre@campigliodolomiti.it](mailto:accommodation3tre@campigliodolomiti.it)
- Each team member is obliged to stay in the accommodation allocated by the LOC for the duration of the event.
- In the buffet area a mouth and nose protector is compulsory, this can be taken off at the table.
- Further hygiene measures according to the hotels policy.
- Check-in of all team members by the team captain ONLY AFTER the Event Registration
- Maintain social distancing in all areas.

## HOW TO REACH THE VENUE FROM THE HOTELS

The race office staff will provide each team with the map with updated directions and the car pass to reach all the race's venues.

- Prefer transport with the teams' own vehicles.
- Avoid stops between the hotel and the venue.
- Use only the team parking and hospitality area assigned and designated for your team.

## EVENT AREA: GENERAL MEASUREMENTS

Maintain social distances

- Remain in assigned and marked team zones.
- The team area is delimited and accessible only for accredited persons.
- Avoid direct contact with other teams.
- Avoid direct contact with employees / press.
- Mouth and nose protectors must be worn at the venue. Exceptions:
  - o While playing sports.
  - o Meals
  - o In the start and warm-up area, athletes do not need mouth and nose protection, but mouth and nose protection is mandatory for all coaches / officials present (FPP2 mask)
- If a team member feels sick or presents COVID-19 symptoms, contact the LOC immediately at the [C19 Support Office](#)
- In case of symptoms, an isolation room is reserved close to the place of the event.

## EVENT AREA: SPECIFIC MEASUREMENTS

### GENERAL ACCESS REGULATION

Access to the course venue is allowed only to authorized and accredited persons, a preferential access corridor is set up for athletes and team officials.

For the accreditation the LOC created different Accreditation Areas to minimize the interaction of different bubble:



RED AREA: Athletes, coaches, ISMF Official, Jury, Timing, LOC  
(Technical Race Area members), TV Production



BLUE AREA: LOC volunteers



YELLOW AREA: press, media, photographers, TV

### STARTING AREA

The entire starting area is an official athlete / team area (red area), fenced off and not accessible for staff and guests. Access control is provided.

VERTICAL and INDIVIDUAL RACE: wide start area, in respect of the distancing rule

SPRINT RACE: mass start, distance of 1,5 m among the athletes

### FINISH AREA

The entire finish area is an official athlete / team area (red area), fenced off and not accessible for staff and guests. Access control is provided.

It is compulsory for athletes wear the mask entering the check material zone.

### MEDIA AREA

- TV/radio/press must maintain social distance from athletes.
- TV/radio/press must wear masks during interviews.

## **SIGNS**

Appropriate signs will be prepared for the better organization of the circulation concept.

## **AWARDS CEREMONIES**

The Ceremonies (Flower and Prize giving ceremonies) will be held in the finish area immediately after the race.

Athelets must wear mask at any ceremonies also when on the podium, pictures will be taken with the mask on.

Keep the designated distance, no hand shaking and remain on the podium step, trophies will be placed on it.

We appeal to EVERYONE to take their OWN RESPONSIBILITY and to comply and implement all measurements and recommendations made!

Guidelines are used to implement or control compliance with the COVID-19 specifications. For your own safety and the safety of other people, you must follow the instructions of the operational staff.

We reserve the right to exclude you from the event and to take legal action in the event of non-compliance with the COVID-19 regulations.

The measurements defined were determined in accordance with the current regulations from:

**2nd march 2021**

The organizer retains the right to make necessary changes, which will be announced immediately.
